Launching a team project with Sociodrama

Running a complete sociodrama through one of its key aspects: a group rehearsal of the life of the project.

In a frame of "as if", the future project team triggers a common vision, asking questions, looking for and giving answers, anticipating the obstacles, collecting resources, developing options, analysing impacts of their own actions, negotiating a modus operandi, etc.

The "rotating subgroups" give new possibilities, train sympathy and a global view on the system.

Intended for group/team activators

Trainers, coaches, consultants, HR professionals, managers, teachers, instructors, educators, social workers, etc.

Objectives

Facilitate the launching of a project in a committing and interactive way, clarifying hopes and risks, openings and potential obstacles involved... until everyone gets a clear representation and is able to integrate completely his/her part in the project.

Content

- timelines in action
- warm-up participants to the roles
- role play
- scenes development
- group roles reversal
- collective characters
- stakeholders analysis – extension of the system
- sociodramatic questioning

At the end of the seminar, participants will be able to

- create a timeline and lead timeline interviews, set in motion
- warm-up people to collective roles
- begin a scene
- facilitate analysis of stakeholders and of the extension of the system
- use techniques of sociodrama, working with groups and teams for the developing, the launch and the follow-up of a project.
